This is how it works:

1. **Volunteer to host a Bash Sign-Up Party**
As a host, you are expected to pay for all the party expenses - dinner, drinks, décor, etc...The party can be hosted by you alone or you can partner with other school families to host it together. Hosting with other families distributes the party expenses and makes it easier come party time because many hands make light work!
2. Decide on the **theme, date, location, # of attendees, and price per person** to attend your event.
3. **Fill-out the Bash Donation Form** and send it to the Bash Sign-Up Party coordinator. The coordinator will then ask you to provide the following information about the party: the party title, names of party host(s), date, location, # of attendees, price per person, a brief description of the party and photos for the website & flyer. This info will be used to promote your party on the Bash website and at school.
4. **Tell everyone at St. Anselm about your awesome event** and invite them to attend! Remind them that we're doing it for the kids!!
5. **Host a fantastic party** that St. Anselm families will remember forever!

Please Note:

As a host, the event itself is a donation to the school so the party expenses are tax deductible.
*These parties are only open to St. Anselm parents & St. Anselm students.
